## **HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR RESEARCH?**

The Lenzing Young Scientist Award gives young scientists around the globe the opportunity to present their research to a wellknown jury and an international audience at the Dornbirn GFC 2024, who are eagerly waiting to see the innovative and inspiring work from the next generation, which might become a game changer in the field of fibers and textiles.

There are three categories recognized in the Lenzing Young Scientist Award 2024:

 Fashion & Circularity: Recyclable textiles meet design (holistic & systematic approaches)

- Participation and presentation of your project at the Dornbirn GFC, Sep. 11<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> 2024
- Coverage of travel expenses to the GFC Dornbirn 2024
- Alternative Raw Materials and Textile Recycling from feedstock to fiber: Innovative disposing & sourcing concepts, innovative fiber separation technologies & raw material / fiber production processes
- Man-made Cellulosic Fiber: New fiber modification processs and technologies

Your submission has to include your CV, a short video/pitch of you presenting your work and a description of the work you have done, this can be your thesis, a project or a paper you have written. All documents must be submitted in English. The jury will also evaluate the quality of your submission. So feel free, get creative and pitch your project in a video!



By submitting your work, you confirm that you have all rights to the work and that you can share it. Restricted research or research that is subject to secrecy may not be submitted.
